Today is surgery day. We know this can be an anxious time and we are always available to answer any questions concerning the procedure. Surgeries are usually preformed between 12-3 pm, and we strive to call every client after a procedure to go over the details with you.

PAC will perform a pre-anesthetic physical exam and we require pre-anesthetic blood work. This blood work consists of a CBC, chemistry panel and electrolyte level. These tests help alert our doctor to the presence of dehydration anemia, infection, diabetes and/or kidney or liver disease that could complicate the procedure. In addition, these tests establish a baseline that can later be used for a more accurate diagnosis and treatment if a problem does arise. Although performing these tests cannot guarantee the absence of complications, it can significantly minimize the risk to your pet and provide you with peace of mind.

Our staff will be monitoring your pet at all times while under anesthesia in order to minimize anesthetic complications. We also have a computerized monitor that records heart rate, blood pressure, oxygen levels, respiration, ECG and core temperature. Some surgeries will require pain management before, during and after surgery. Additionally, pain medication may be sent home with you.

Our clinic does not provide 24 hour care. If your pet requires further medical supervision during the hours we are closed, you have to the option to make arrangements to pick him/her up from PAC and take him/her to one of the area facilities that provide care during hours the hospital is not staffed.

To protect other patients, all pets must be free of internal and external parasites, and must be current on vaccinations. If not, they will be treated at the owner's expense. We will make an effort to inform you of any such charges and fees involved in treatment under this paragraph. If you cannot be reached you will still be obligated to pay the total charges for your pet's medical attention. All pet's that are admitted to PAC will be given a Capstar (\$6.10) tablet to reduce our risk of flea infestation.

OVER

It may be necessary to provide medical and/or surgical procedures which are not anticipated for the safety or care of your pet. Failure to be reached on the day of the procedure may result in postponement of the surgery/treatment. Please CHECK ( ✓ ) ONE OPTION that will allow us to handle your pets' decisions in his/her best interest (i.e., tooth extraction, IV fluids, additional pain medication, etc.) if needed.

**MICROCHIP:** IF your pet has not been microchipped, now is the time to do so. We offer a 10% discount off of microchips when they are implanted while under anesthesia. This permanent chip is registered with the information you provide to get your pet back if ever lost.

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**CATS ONLY – Pain medication**

Simbadol is a pain medication injection for cats that lasts for 24 hours. It is administered before surgery to reduce post-surgical pain. If the cat is in less pain, he or she will recover faster.
